

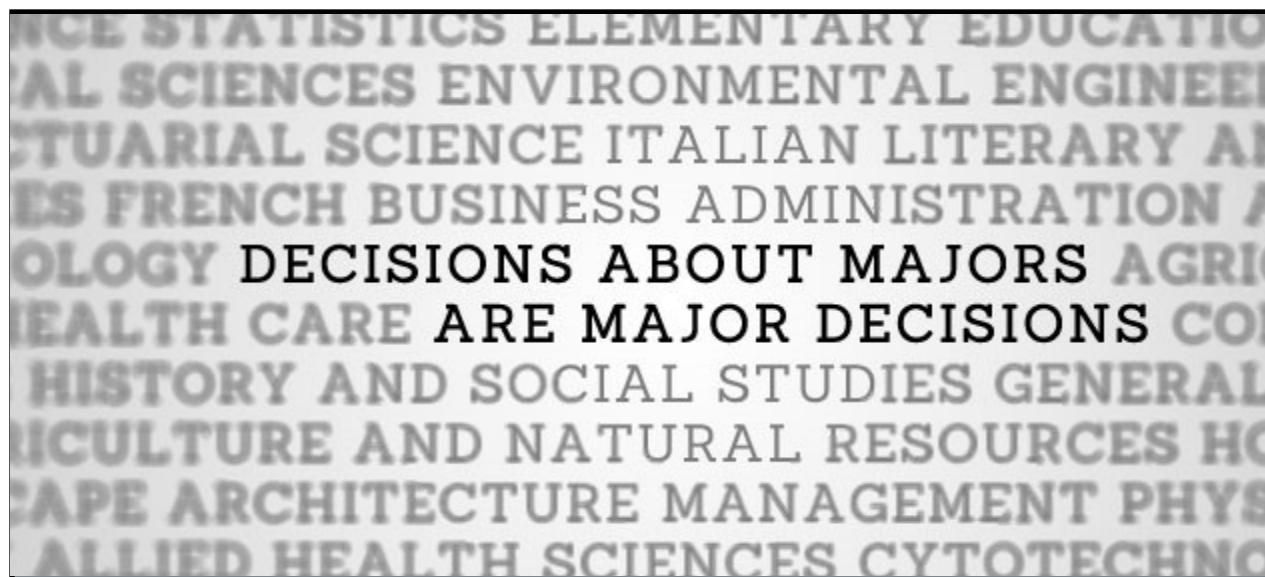
Making Major Decisions
